Your greyhound will have all current vaccinations, will have been test for heartworm, will have been spayed/neutered, and will have had its teeth cleaned. You will be given all of the proper documentation for your greyhound upon pick-up.

On the day you pick up your greyhound, you will need to bring a leash. In addition, you must purchase a Martingale collar to prevent your greyhound from getting loose.

NEVER let your greyhound run loose unless you are in a secured, fenced-in area. Greyhounds run very fast and they don't stop for cars. Remember, a loose greyhound is a dead greyhound.
